Located at the north-eastern end of the Palace grounds, the Apothekestrakt boasts a selection of spacious meeting and event rooms. Nine seminar rooms in total, plus an elegant state room, ranging in size from 60m² to 260m², offer ideal venues for all types of event. Light-filled hospitality rooms in a variety of sizes also make the perfect setting for networking events, whether at cocktail tables or exhibition stands, and provide ample space for a range of catering options.

Our largest event venue, the Schönbrunn Orangery, is an impressive hall encompassing 700m² of event space, extendable to 1,000m² during the summer months. The Orangery likewise makes a perfect setting for trade exhibitions and formal dinner events.

Today, the Vienna Furniture Museum—formerly known as the Imperial Furniture Collection, serving as the court furniture depository—is a truly unique institution, combining the functions of storeroom, workshop, administrative centre and museum in a concept not found anywhere else in the world.

The depository is dedicated to the restoration, conservation and stewardship of the collection holdings. A curated selection of the most significant and visually-impressive pieces is displayed in the Museum's exhibition galleries.

Over the centuries, what was once considered merely a “royal lumber room” has become one of the world's foremost furniture collections.

The Museum foyer and the expansive inner courtyard offer ample space for events.



For trade fairs, exhibitions and indeed weddings too, the expansive, light-filled Orangerie is an ideal venue, offering ample space for multiple exhibitors.


