Apothekertrakt (Apothecaries' Wing)

A place for extraordinary encounters

The Apothekertrakt on the east side of the Schönbrunn palace grounds is the perfect multipurpose events centre, the ideal setting for conferences and meetings, as well as a venue for exhibitions, trade fairs, dinners and weddings. The ten rooms with their different sizes and atmospheres are linked by spacious light-flooded areas that are ideal for taking a break. An outstanding aspect is the harmonious interaction between the historical building and the modern equipment.

The terraces in the Orangery Garden and the Apothecaries' Court provide outside areas that connect to the ground floor barrier-free facilities by means of direct access routes.





White and Gold Rooms and Great Gallery

Where events breathe history

The rooms directly in the Palace sparkle with their historical and imperial furnishing. Precious leaf gold decorates the White and Gold Rooms on the palace's ground floor. These four rooms are each of a different size, and can be selected to meet the size of the event. The terrace into the Palace Park presents a breathtaking view of the Gloriette.

The Great Gallery on the palace's main floor communicates a flair of unadulterated exclusiveness. Only available during evening hours, the rooms have an atmosphere that takes you back to the age of the Empire.

Orangery

Baroque festive culture and garden splendor

The Orangery provides an imposing setting for your events. The room, $700m^2$ in size, its appearance elegant and yet reticent, is ideal for staging your event in a style that is both traditionally imperial as well as modern – regardless of whether it is a dinner, a lecture or an exhibition. Give your guests a feast for their eyes with the direct connection between the Orangery garden and the banqueting hall. Let the gravel forecourt to the Orangery be transformed into your event's elegant interval zone. And what is more, in the summer months you can hire the Pflanzenorangerie (Plant Orangery) – all 1200m² of it.

An exciting architectural setting

In the largest room, Maria Theresia, once used for overwintering rare citron trees, the slightly curving shape and rounded arches allow for a variety of arrangement possibilities.

Two screens provide an audience of up to 200 with a good view of presentations at conferences. Numerous lighting possibilities – including four elegant chandeliers – can be controlled separately to create the perfect atmosphere. The large double doors give a view of the Baroque Orangery Garden, with a terrace that can be integrated into your event.

The adjoining Habsburg Room is popular as an extension for additional items on the programme, but can also be used for registry office weddings.

Trade fairs and exhibitions





The Maria Theresia room is an elegant presentation area for trade fairs and exhibitions. In combination with the Orangery Garden foyer or the Spitzhof foyer, it constitutes a spacious trade fair and exhibitor surface that is open without restrictions to all guests thanks to its location on the ground floor and its barrier-free access.

A place for encounters



The smallest of our rooms is ideal for making small groups feel particularly at ease. The particular attraction is its direct access to the leafy outer area in the Spitzhof, whose special feature is its design in the form of a Japanese garden.

Alongside the classical use as seminar room, it is often used for press conferences or as an organisation office.

The charm of a vaulted interior



Located directly on the Apothecaries' Court, the light-flooded Franz Joseph Room is ideal for conferences for up to 120 persons.

Its vaulted ceiling and the historical window shutters give it a tangible historical flair. The Glasaula can be used for refreshments during breaks or to end the evening. The Apothecaries' Court can also be used for this purpose in case of fine weather.

Alongside use as a classical conference room, Room 9 is also ideal as an extended area for breaks or for exhibitors.

The four doors give access to the Spitzhof foyer. A bar area is concealed behind a rolling shutter and can be integrated at any time.

Located on the edge of the palace park, the Apothekertrakt is an idyllic place of calm in the heart of the city. The closeness to nature is created through our outside areas.

Orangery Garden terrace



The Orangery Garden terrace can be reached directly from the Maria Theresia Room and the Orangery Garden foyer. Set away from the bustle in the palace park, the Orangery Garden is a place for relaxation with a Mediterranean flair. Directly in front of the terrace is the vineyard, behind which opens up the perfect view over fountains, palms and the sunset – a magnificent setting to bring the evening to a wonderful close.







Apothecaries' Court

In the shade of chestnut and lime trees, with a bubbling fountain to calm the mind, this cool spot is ideal for a break even on a hot day. The Apothecaries' Court is directly connected to the Glasaula, ideal for breaks, and the Orangery Garden foyer.

During the day, these two rooms are the central point and highlight of visits to the palace. The Great Gallery was lavishly renovated in 2012 and now once again shines in full glory as an imperial setting for magnificent concerts and evening events.

The rooms with gilded carvings and the reconstructed parquet floor bring the imperial glory back to life. The french windows give onto the Baroque palace garden and the Gloriette. The terrace can also be included in the event. Registry office weddings are also extremely popular. The rooms, available individually or in combination, give any event a very special flair.

During the Baroque epoch the Orangery was not used merely as a place for keeping rare and exotic plants. It was also a central location for courtly festive culture.

Keeping to this tradition, the Orangery today offers an imposing setting for your events. The space covers 700 m2 and impresses all comers with its elegant appearance, accommodating both a traditional and a modern scenario for your event – whether dinner, lecture or exhibition. Impress your guests with the direct connection between the Orangery garden and the banqueting hall. Enjoy the gravelled patio in front of the Orangery as your event's interval zone. And on top of this you can hire the Plant Orangery as well during the summer months, all 1200 square metres of it.

The Maria Theresia room is located in the Apothekertrakt on the edge of the palace grounds and is where, in the 18th century, rare citrus trees were cultivated. In combination with spacious ancillary rooms, it provides many possibilities for arranging your wedding celebrations (up 250 persons). Enjoy the shady Apothecaries' Court and the idyllic Orangery Garden terrace – a leafy oasis with grapevines, roses and palms. You can also celebrate your registry office marriage in the Apothekertrakt.

Includes: Hire of the Maria Theresia and Habsburg rooms, coordination and supervision up to midnight (extension possible), use of all open spaces (Apothecaries' Court and Orangery Garden terrace) and the spacious foyer.





White and Gold Rooms

The White and Gold Rooms on the ground floor of the Palace are available for your registry office wedding. In these historic rooms, you can tie the knot in the presence of up to 120 guests, followed by agape on the terrace of the White and Gold Rooms with its view of the palace garden and the Gloriette, an idyllic setting for unforgettable wedding photos.
